Entering Reading Achievement Levels

1. From Special Functions -> School Functions, click Reading Achievement Entry.
2. Select the group of students you want to enter values for and click Submit.

Find Students Missing Reading Achievement Levels

1. From Special Functions -> School Functions, click Reading Achievement Missing Students Report.
2. The report can be re-sorted by clicking the column headings.
