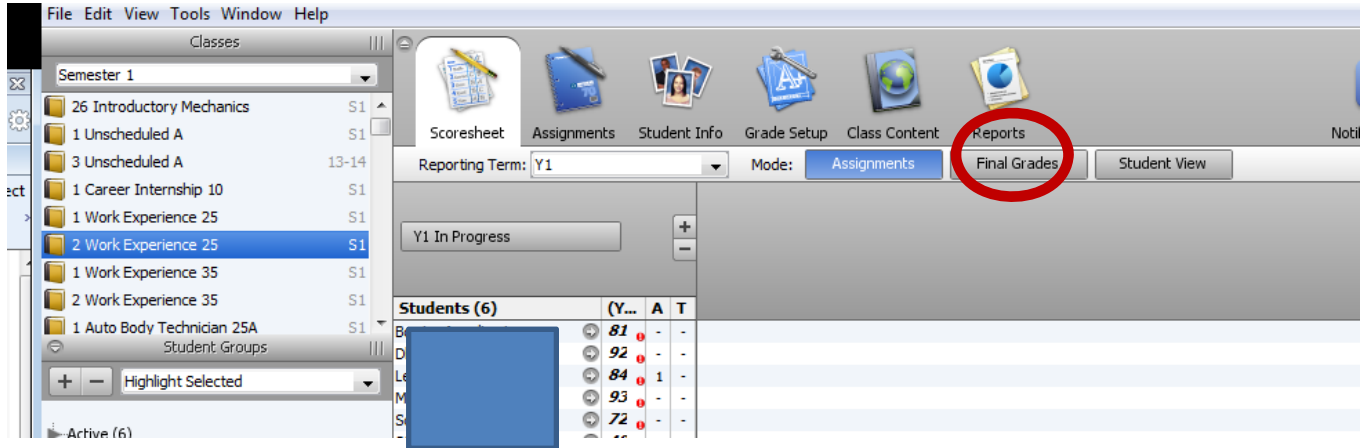

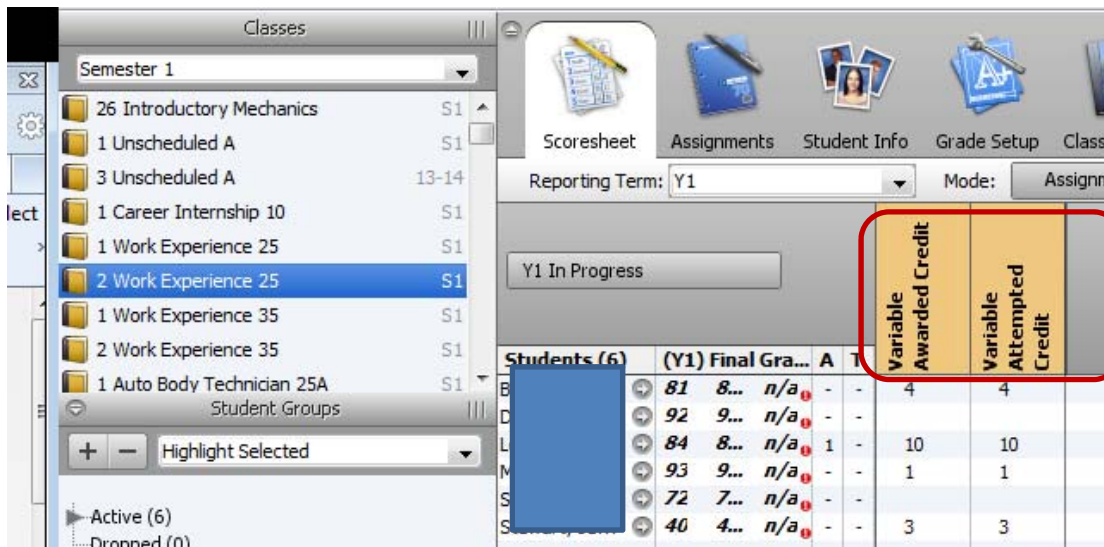
Permanently Store Grades in the usual way. The variable credit is preserved and saved.

TEACHER INSTRUCTIONS – Variable Credit courses

In the teacher's gradebook, enter the assignment/ course marks in the usual way. When the course is complete, click on the Final Grades tab.



There will now be columns for the credits attempted and awarded. Enter the actual credit earned by each student, if it is not the default value for the course. For example, the first student gets 4 credits, the second student gets the default value of 5 credits, the third student gets 10 credits, and the fourth student gets 1 credit.



GOTCHA: Earned credit overrides calculations. So if student has a failing mark, but you enter awarded credits, the student gets the credits, even though he/she shouldn't.

Eg. In the example above, the last student gets 3 credits, but shouldn't because of the failing mark of 40.
